


# HEALTH INSURANCE OFFERED BY THE POLISH NATIONAL HEALTH FUND (NFZ)

### HEALTH INSURANCE OFFERED BY

NFZ:

- voluntary medical insurance;
- public;
- ensures the same access to public healthcare services in Poland as in the case of Polish citizens.





#### WHO CAN BE COVERED?

- non-EU students;
- students having the Pole's Card;
- EU students not covered by the medical insurance in their countries of residence.






### EU students covered by the medical insurance in their countries of residence:

public health services in Poland free of charge if they have a valid European Health Insurance Card.



### THE MONTHLY COST OF THE INSURANCE OFFERED BY NFZ:

- PLN 55.80 (EUR 12) for non-EU students;
- free of charge for students having the Pole's Card.





### REQUIRED DOCUMENTS (original + copy):

#### non-EU citizens:

- a valid passport;
- •a valid visa or residence permit;
- •a document from the Faculty confirming your student status (please ask your Dean's Office for this document);
- •a document confirming residence in Poland (e.g. certificate from a dorm, rental agreement);
- •2 application forms for the insurance of the Polish National Health Fund;

#### + students having Polish origin:

• a valid Pole's card or the Decision of the Consul of the Republic of Poland on the Polish origin.



### If you are under 18...

 the consent of your parent for concluding the agreement with the Polish National Health Fund + the copy of the first page of


your parent's passport.


### After signing the agreement with NFZ...

#### **NON-EU CITIZENS:**

- fill in the ZUS ZZA form;
- Polish Social Insurance Institution (ZUS) within 7 days.

#### STUDENTS WITH THE POLE'S CARD:

 contact your <u>Dean's Office</u> in order to submit a copy of the agreement signed with NFZ and a copy of your Pole's Card within 7 days.






NON-EU CITIZENS who are going to spend in Poland over 30 DAYS.

**EU CITIZENS** who are going to spend in Poland over 90 DAYS.


Where can I register my temporary residence? In one of the District Offices of the City of Warsaw.
















### What documents are required?

- passport or national ID card (EU citizens);
- visa (non-EU citizens);
- rental agreement or the confirmation of accommodation in a WUT dormitory;
- temporary residence form.

#### PESEL number

If you register your residence in the District Office of the City of

Warsaw, you will be automatically assigned a PESEL number.

#### What is a PESEL number?

A number in the Universal Electronic System for Registration of the Population.







### What is a PESEL number for?

 checking if you are covered by the health insurance of the Polish National Health Fund, e.g. if you need to go to public hospital or a medical centre;

 enables a doctor to give you an e-prescription or ereferral during the online consultation.






